The weather has definitely turned toward fall & winter. There are fewer warm days, and even the diehard RC racers check the winds before they go out. They stay fewer hours than just a couple weeks ago, too. I've seen Dave & Ralph still risking their aircraft. Good on them for being brave! I sure could use some Indian Summer. Maybe this weekend?

Jim Slapikes has arranged for a landscaper to upgrade our RC racing oval track. We approved this project at last month's SHARKS meeting. We're still asking for donations to lower Jim's personal contribution. So far that's up to \$900, but the project will be over \$4000. Please consider adding your personal funds to this project, over and above your SHARKS dues. They hope to deliver the clay onsite this week and start the actual work next week. The off-road track should stay open during construction if we get some decent weather.

The roofing project for the garage looks like it'll move at least to spring. We have no leaks yet, so we should be OK. Let me know if you see any dampness on the ceiling or puddles on the floor and we'll apply a temporary fix.

Oostburg indoor flying will start soon! It's on Wednesday nights from 6-9PM starting December 3, and will run until April 29. We're continuing the \$10 fee for flyers, which all goes to the school district. Spectators are always free. Enter through the gym doors towards the north end of the building. Brian from the Kettle Area Flyers is hoping to add some weekend hours, too.

November's AHC Movie Night is tomorrow, Friday, November 14 when we'll show <u>Heroes on Deck: World War II on Lake Michigan</u> at 7PM. Indoor flyers and helpers should be there at 6PM. Let Dave Meyer or Graham know if you can lend a hand. Hours count towards your club dues work obligation.

Make sure your AMA or ROAR memberships are up to date so you can complete your 2026 SHARKS Membership Application, which is included in this newsletter.

Unless you're an opt-out member, remember you needed 15 hrs of club benefiting activities in 2025 to complete your obligation. This includes additional adult members where the first member is an opt-out. Please include \$5/unfulfilled hour with your 2026 application.

Remember that besides your AMA membership, flyers also need an FAA registry number that you can use on all your aircraft and your TRUST certificate. I noticed that mine are coming due.

If you're planning to be a new SHARKS Park member, you have the choice of joining as an AMA Park Pilot or a ROAR member. You only need one or the other to cover your required insurance, but the AMA Park Pilot license would allow you to fly small electric models as well as race. If you plan on visiting other ROAR facilities, then the ROAR membership would be the way to go. Right now we're one of two affiliated clubs in Wisconsin, but the choice is yours. You'll find links to the <u>AMA</u> & <u>ROAR</u> on our links page,

https://www.sharksrc.com/related.php ,or just click on the names here. Be sure to include your AMA license or ROAR membership # on our 2026 SHARKS Membership Application. A SHARKS membership will be required for use of our facilities from now on.

The FAA registration is only \$5 for 3 years, so it's better to do it than have someone stop in and shut you down for being non-compliant. Here's the link to sign up or renew: https://faadronezone.faa.gov



If this is a renewal, there's a Log In link under the link for the Exception for Recreational Flyers, where you'll enter using your login and password from when you first applied for Certification. If this is your first time, click the Register button link for the Exception for Recreational Flyers and follow the instructions. If you try to enter any other way, you'll have a good chance of ending up at the wrong place which could be a scam site.

Make sure you print out your certificate when you successfully complete the test. It's not saved anywhere, and you'll have to complete the test again to get a new certificate!
